Day 1: Saigon arrival

Upon arrival, you will be received by your guide and transferred to your hotel. Dinner at the restaurant.

Day 2: Saigon - Cu Chi - Half day city tour

Visit Cu Chi Tunnels in the Morning which were never discovered by American Force. These tunnels are stretching over 200 km and were important Viet Cong base during the American War. This underground network, dug by hand connected command posts hospital shelter and weapon factories.

Back to Saigon and enjoy lunch at Indian restaurant.

Afternoon, visit wind through District One before heading to the famous Saigon landmarks. Visit the post office and the Cathedral of Notre Dame as well as pass by the ornate City Hall (Hotel De Ville) and old Opera House. Visit The Unification Palace which formerly was Independence palace of the South Vietnamese President. Spend time to shopping at Ben Thanh market, one of the biggest markets in Saigon with a lot of souvenir and goods. Dinner at the restaurant.

Overnight in Saigon

Day 3: Saigon - Mekong River

Visit the outskirts of Saigon and begins the tour on the beautiful countryside road. Take a private boat trip to Mekong River Island near My Tho and stop to visit fruit orchard and listen to traditional music. Enjoy carried lunch. Then returning My Tho explores the small canals and lush jungle scenery by hand – rowed sampan. Back to Saigon in the afternoon.

Day 4: Saigon – Siem Reap – Half day city tour

After breakfast transfer to the airport to fly to Siem Reap by VN811 SGN-REP 11:40-12:40

Arrive at Siem Reap, Pick up from the airport and have lunch at the restaurant. Then transfer to the hotel for check in (after 14:00). After freshening up we will visit Artisan D'Angkor (<http://www.artisansdangkor.com>) which is famous for its traditional craft skills products are available such as stone carving, wood carving, lacquering, gilding and silk processing and the local market. We will drive to Phnom Bakeng for sunset view. Dinner at the restaurant.

Overnight in Siem Reap

Day 5: Siem Reap tour

After Breakfast we will explore wondrous ancient ruins with the South Gate of Angkor Thom, which is famous for its series of colossal human faces carved in stone, the impressive Bayon Temple, the Royal Enclosure, Phimeanakas, the Elephant Terrace, the Terrace of the Leper King, then continue to Preah Khan which was built in 1191 during the reign of King Jayavarman VII. He was a warrior king celebrated for reconstructing the Khmer Empire after a period of fragmentation. Jayavarman first made a name for himself in 1165, when the news of a rebellion reached. Rushing home from the Cham Kingdom, where he resided, he arrived late to stop the usurper Tribhuvanadityavarman from crowning himself King of the Khmers.

Afternoon, we will visit the jungle covered temple of Ta Prohm which is an incredible sight. There are enormous fig trees and gigantic creepers which embrace themselves in the stone foundations of the structure giving the impression of man's creation being reclaimed by the powerful forces of nature.

Later this afternoon, we will complete our temple tours to the most complete temple of Angkor Wat. This architectural masterpiece was constructed in the 12th century and covers an area of about 210 hectares. We stroll around this massive edifice, seeing the many galleries with Columns, libraries, pavilions, courtyards and ponds full of water reflecting the towering temple.

Tonight, we will enjoy one hour foot massage. Dinner at the restaurant.

Overnight in Siem Reap

Day 6: Siem Reap – Silk farm - Choueng Kneas village

Visit Pouk district by car about 15 Km in the West of Siem Reap town. Visit the silk farm, a fascinating farm/workshop where you can see the entire silk creation process including growing the food for the silk worms, breeding the worms, silk extraction and refinement, traditional kit dying pattern creation and looming. Retail silk and souvenir shop. On the way back, visit the Western Baray (Baray Occidental) measuring 8 km by 2.3 km which provides water for the intensive cultivation of lands around Angkor. We also visit Landmine museum on the way.



DON'T DREAM IT, DISCOVER IT

Afternoon, we will take Tuk Tuk (the most common taxi in Cambodia) to the floating village of Choueng Kneas village, where you will take the boat to visit the way of life of the poor people of Cambodi along with schools, restaurants, hospitals and much more floating on the great lake of Tonle sap. You may even see enterprising children floating in buckets selling soft drinks and floating pig pen.

Overnight in Siem Reap

Day 7: Siem Reap departure

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for departure flight.
